MAUNDY THURSDAY (*18th April*)

7.30 p.m.: The Mass of the Lord's Supper at St Arvans Church

Sung Eucharist, Procession of the Blessed Sacrament to the Altar of Repose, stripping of the altars and Watch until midnight

GOOD FRIDAY (19th April)

9.30 a.m. Mattins, Litany & Antecomunion at St Deiniol's, Itton

3 p.m. – 4 p.m.. The Liturgy of the Lord's Passion at St Arvans Church

A starkly simple ceremony which includes the Passion Gospel, an address, the Proclamation of the Cross and Holy Communion from the reserved Sacrament

EASTER EVE or HOLY SATURDAY (20th April)

Our Churches will be decorated for Easter today

7.30 p.m. The Easter Vigil at St Arvans Church

(The Easter Vigil is an ancient & dramatic liturgy which includes the lighting of the New Fire in the churchyard, the blessing of the Easter Candle, a series of Bible readings and prayers telling the story of our redemption, the blessing of the Baptismal Waters and the First Eucharist of Easter)
