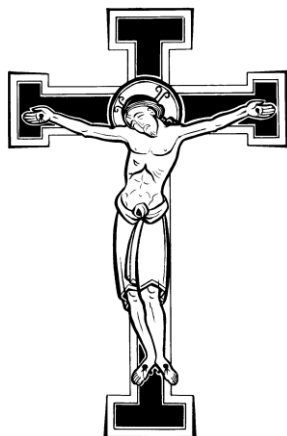

Repose, stripping of the altars and
Watch until midnight

GOOD FRIDAY (19th April)

9.30 a.m. Mattins, Litany &
Ante-communion at St Deiniol's, Itton
3 p.m. – 4 p.m.. The Liturgy of the
Lord's Passion at St Arvans Church
*A starkly simple ceremony which
includes the Passion Gospel, an
address, the Proclamation of the
Cross and Holy Communion from the
Sacrament reserved on Maundy
Thursday evening*

EASTER EVE or HOLY SATURDAY (20th April)

*Our Churches will be decorated for
Easter today*

7.30 p.m. The Easter Vigil at St Arvans Church

*The Easter Vigil is an ancient &
dramatic liturgy which includes the
lighting of the New Fire in the
churchyard, the blessing of the Easter
Candle, a series of Bible readings and
prayers telling the story of our
redemption, the blessing of the
Baptismal Waters and the First
Eucharist of Easter*
